

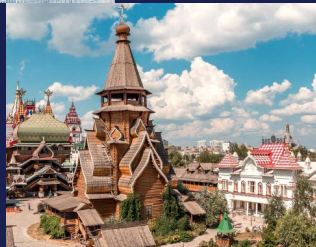

WHAT IS THE REASON FOR YOUR INTEREST IN RUSSIA?

L.X.: I have never been to Russia, and our university has connections with Russian universities. Therefore, we decided to visit this country.

S.H.: In China, people know very well what the Soviet Union was, but we still do not know what modern Russia is. We want to understand what it is, to know its culture.

THREE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS YOU LEARNED ABOUT MODERN RUSSIA

S.H.: Firstly, people in Russia turned out to be quite open. They are free to express their points of view, and there is almost no age barrier. Secondly, Russia combines history and innovation. For example, the building of Moscow State University was built in the middle of the last century, but it is still used, developed and is considered the largest educational center. Thirdly, there is a convenient transport system. We like the metro, it is very clear, we like its infrastructure. Here we can understand where to go without asking for help.

WOULD YOU RECOMMEND YOUR FRIENDS TO VISIT RUSSIA?

S.H.: Sure! In our opinion, it is worth coming to Russia for two things. The first is the nature itself, the landscapes. The second is culture, especially architecture. There are many temples in Russia, old buildings that have been preserved from tsarist and Soviet times.

TELL US ABOUT YOUR CLASSES IN ROSNOU

L.X.: We had classes where we were told about the position of Russia in the modern world, there were classes in the Russian language, and there was a lesson when we painted emblems and attractions of Russian cities. We really enjoyed Russian language classes.
